



Psychological Assessment Provider

Nashville Child and Family Wellness Center (NCFWC) is in search of full- and/or part-time professionals to perform psychological and psychoeducational evaluations of children, adolescents, and young adults. The person in this position must proficiently perform assessments of cognitive abilities; educational achievement; and socio-emotional, behavioral, and adaptive functioning with children, adolescents, and young adults. This position is for an independent contractor, and reimbursement is dependent upon each completed evaluation. Depending on the needs of the Center as well as the assessment provider, a part-time or full-time salaried position may become available once the contractor has become established at the clinic.

Principal Duties and Responsibilities:

- 1) Conduct psychoeducational evaluations using standardized test batteries, interviews, and observations to understand learning, behavior, and emotional problems (e.g., specific learning disorders, ADHD, ASD, depression, anxiety, intellectual giftedness).
- 2) Interpret the results of evaluations to provide appropriate diagnoses and to inform specific interventions and accommodations that will help individuals achieve their goals and improve well-being.
- 4) Conduct a thorough interpretive feedback session with family members and youth, when indicated, to review the results and answer questions.
- 5) Provide consultation with a client's educational, medical, and mental health providers as needed.
- 6) Work collaboratively with the Director of Assessments and other Center providers.

Preferred Education/Experience:

- Doctoral level degree in psychology, or related field, with Health Service Provider designation in the state of Tennessee (preferred)
- Doctoral level degree in psychology, or related field, with Temporary License in the state of Tennessee
- Master's Degree in Psychology/licensed as CPA

- Master's Degree in Psychology/licensed as a Psychological Examiner/Senior Psychological Examiner
- At least three years of experience working with children
